Also present were Superintendent Kendall Steffensen, Elementary Principal Adam Patrick, and High School Principal Mark Brahmer. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The board discussed complying with PPACA-Obama Care, the budget, State Aid, property tax valuation and levy, Mr. Steffensen's salary, Mr. Brahmer's salary, non-certified staff salaries, and policy review.
