The Pierce Public Schools Board of Education met for a special meeting at 6:30 p.m. in the High School Conference Room. Members present were Dave Lienemann, Robert Hoffmann, Ron Woslager, Ted Krienke, and Dan Unseld. Also present were Superintendent Kendall Steffensen, Elementary Principal Adam Patrick, High School Principal Mark Brahmer, Assistant Principal/Activities Director Johnnie Ostermeyer, and three guests.

A welcome was extended to the public and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Lienemann moved and Unseld seconded a motion to excuse Kevin Flesner from the meeting. Voting unanimous with Flesner absent, motion carried.

Flesner joined the meeting at 6:31 p.m. There was no communication from the public.

A discussion was held about the qualifications, candidate pool, and pay for the position of activity director at the high school.

Woslager moved and Flesner seconded a motion to hire an activities director only and not an assistant principal from the best applicants in the candidate pool. Voting as follows: Flesner-yes, Unseld-yes, Woslager-yes, Lienemann-no, Hoffmann-yes, and Krienke-no. Motion carried 4-2.

Unseld moved and Lienemann seconded a motion to adjourn. Voting unanimous, meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
