FFA TRACTOR DRIVING CONTEST

THE PIERCE FFA COMPETED IN THE ANNUAL FFA ALUMNI TRACTOR DRIVING CONTEST. EIGHT PEOPLE FROM THE PIERCE FFA CHAPTER COMPETED IN THE CONTEST THIS YEAR. THE CHAMPION OF THIS YEAR'S TRACTOR DRIVING CONTEST WAS CARTER ANDERSON OF PIERCE. THE CONTEST CONSISTED OF TWO SEPARATE COURSES A FOUR-WHEEL WAGON AND A TWO-WHEEL WAGON. THE FOUR-WHEEL CONTEST CONSISTED OF PULLING THE WAGON OUT OF ONE BOX AND BACKING THE WAGON UP INTO ANOTHER BOX. THE TWO-WHEEL CONTEST CONSISTED OF WEAVING THROUGH A SET OF CONES. THESE TESTS INCLUDED PARTS ID, DAILY MAINTENANCE, SAFETY PROCEDURES, AND FINDING SPECIFIC THINGS IN A MANUAL.
