

## Stakeholder Diagnostic

### **Areas of Notable Achievement**

1. Which area(s) indicate the overall highest level of satisfaction or approval?

On the parent opinion surveys, the highest satisfaction levels came from the statements, “Up-to-date computers and other technologies are used in our school to help students learn,” and “The education offered to student at our school is of high quality.”

On the student opinion surveys, the highest satisfaction levels came from the statements, “My teachers want students to learn,” and “Up-to-date computers and other technologies are used in our school to help students learn.”

On the teacher opinion surveys, the highest satisfaction levels came from the statements, “In our school, students have access to a variety of resources to help them succeed in their learning, such as technology, media centers, and libraries,” and “Up-to-date computers and other technologies are used in our school to help students learn.”

2. Which area(s) show a trend toward increasing stakeholder satisfaction or approval?

The area that shows a trend toward increased stakeholder satisfaction is support for student learning on all of the stakeholder surveys, with the exception of the survey administered to the elementary students. Their trend toward increased satisfaction was in the quality of the instructional programs.

3. Which of the above reported findings are consistent with findings from other stakeholder feedback sources?

We did not have enough data to make an accurate measurement of this question. We will improve upon this for our next cycle.

## **Areas in Need of Improvement**

1. Which area(s) indicate the overall lowest level of satisfaction or approval?

Hands down, on all surveys, the area that indicated the lowest level of satisfaction was relating to bullying. The statement, “There are no problems with bullies at our school,” received the lowest marks from all stakeholders surveys.

2. Which area(s) show a trend toward decreasing stakeholder satisfaction or approval?

The areas that show a trend toward decreasing stakeholder satisfaction are the school climate and environment for learning. On the parent surveys, another area that showed a trend toward decreasing satisfaction was resource management.

3. What are the implications for these stakeholder perceptions?

The implications of these perceptions are that the areas that show low or decreasing satisfaction are areas we as a school district need to address.
