TICKET SALES:

All tickets sales will be online only, all reserved seating, no general admission. No onsite sales will be available. Single session tickets will be sold for \$10 each, plus online fees. Tickets will go on sale at 10:00 AM CT on February 1. A link will be shared with coaches and posted on the NCA web page prior to February 1.

Fans and teams should make plans to attend only the session they are competing in so that family members that want to attend in person can see their student-athletes compete. The daily schedule is set by class sessions to allow approximately 1,100 reserved seats for family members of performing student-athletes. The reserved seats will be sold on-line in pods of 1, 2, 3 or 4 reserved seats with social distancing built in. No more than a pod of 4 tickets can be purchased in a single online transaction. Handicapped seats will be available to purchase online for each session. For children 2 years-old and younger, lap sitting is available, no online purchase is required. The arena will be cleared immediately after each session's awards ceremony.

Public gates will open 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled performance each session.

Grand Island city-wide MASK mandate will be enforced for the general public and teams.
