The Pierce Public Schools Board of Education met the regular meeting a 6:30 p.m. in the High School boardroom. Members present were Ted Krienke, Robert Hoffmann, Dave Lienemann, Adam Venteicher, Kevin Flesner and Dan Unseld. Also present were Superintendent Kendall Steffensen, Elementary Principal Adam Patrick, High School Principal Mark Brahmer, Activities Director Darren Sindelar and several guests.

A welcome was extended to the public, roll call was taken, open meetings act pointed out and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

No communication from the public.

Venteicher moved and Lienemann seconded a motion to approve the consent agenda including the approval of minutes of the previous meeting, the approval of claims and payment of bills and financial reports. Voting unanimous, motion carried.
