Lienemann moved and Flesner seconded a motion stating the board has reviewed the district's parent involvement policy. Voting unanimous with Woslager absent, motion carried.

Lienemann moved and Hoffmann seconded a motion stating the board has reviewed the district's Title I parent involvement policy after conducting a public hearing. Voting unanimous with Woslager absent, motion carried.
