The Pierce Public Schools Board of Education met for the regular monthly meeting at 6:30 p.m. in the High School boardroom. Members present were Kevin Flesner, Adam Venteidher, Dave Lienemann, Robert Hoffmann, Ted Krienke and Dan Unseld. Also present were Superintendent Kendall Steffensen, High School Principal Mark Brahmer, Activities Director Darren Sindelar and two guests.

A welcome was extended to the public, roll call was taken, open meetings act pointed out and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Jacob Hurla updated the board on the progress of updating the HVAC and the lighting in both school buildings and auditorium.
