Old Business	
Supply Sheds	Two sheds were purchased for playground equipment. They have been constructed and are currently being used.
Corn Hole Boards	Six sets of corn hole boards with the Pierce Bluejay logo were purchased for physical education. They have been delivered to the school.
Sensory Walk	Paint supplies and stencils for the sensory walk did not arrive in time for the high school community service day so volunteers will be needed. The tentative date for painting the sensory walk will be Wednesday, November 25 th so that the paint can cure for a few days before students return to school. This date is dependent upon weather and volunteers.
Cookie Dough Fundraiser	Money from the fundraiser was counted and orders were reviewed. Purchases will arrive on Friday, November 6 th . Pick up reminders will be sent to parents as the day approaches. Volunteers are needed to unload and organize the items when they arrive.
Boxtop Prizes	Gatorade and suckers will be used as prizes for Boxtops. Students who bring Boxtops will drop them off in the administrative offices and will choose a prize.
New Business	
Request for Deodorant- 6 th Grade	A request was made to PATS to provide deodorant in the 6 th grade classroom. The request was denied as parental preference needs to be taken into account regarding hygiene. Mr. Suehl will look into puberty education and when that will be done. Typically, fifth grade students participate but the class last year did not because of COVID.
October 16 th Snack Sales	Brandy Price will send reminders to those who volunteered to bring snacks.

items. Brandy Price will purchase more items.
